Gentlemen:

The storm sewer improvements at Auglaize Acres, performed by Steinke Backhoe, have been completed as per specifications. There were no non-performance items deleted from the contract and the total bid of \$ 20,149.52 is due to the contractor.

There were several "extra" work items performed by the contractor due to the: extra excavation for the installation of the buried electrical line; excavation of an extremely large flag pole base; hookup of extra subsurface tile encountered; sawing the existing blacktop on the north side of the building to provide a straighter edge for the proposed paving; excavating area for the dumpster pad and installing 304 base material; extra backhoe with dump truck for additional trench repair (during excavation, bricks, rocks, etc. was removed from the initially planned narrow trenches causing the existing parking lot to be undermined adjacent to the trench - - therefore the trenches had to be sawed wider than planned, more material removed and disposed of, additional aggregate backfill and asphalt used. Final quantity of asphalt placed in the trenches was 71% greater than planned due to the caving of the trenches).

Hirschfeld; and,

WHEREAS, said annexation petition was placed in the Commissioners' Journal 110, pages 163 - 170 on September 01, 2011 pursuant to ORC 709.023; and,

WHEREAS, the requirements for the filing of said petition were all met by Agent Fleagle, including:

- 1.) The petition meets all the requirements set forth in, and was filed in the manner provided, in the Ohio Revised Code Section 709.021.
- 2.) The person who signed the petition represents 100% of the owner of the property or the representative thereof; signature having been obtained in the time frame required.
- 3.) An accurate legal description of the perimeter of the territory proposed to be annexed.
- 4.) An accurate map or plat of the territory.
- 5.) Named the party acting as agent for the petitioners.
- 6.) A list of all tracts, lots or parcels in the territory proposed to be annexed and all tracts, lots or parcels located adjacent to the territory to be annexed, listing the name of owner, mailing address and permanent parcel number from the County Auditor's system (ORC 319.28); and,

WHEREAS, the petitioner requested that the special procedure be used and waived its right to appeal any action taken by the Board of County Commissioners; and,

WHEREAS, the following Conditions for Annexation under ORC 709.023 have been met:

- A. The petition meets all the requirements set forth in, and was filed in the manner provided in, ORC 709.021.
- B. The persons who signed the petition are owners of property located in the territory proposed to be annexed, and they constitute all owners in the territory.
- C. The territory proposed to be annexed does not exceed 500 acres.
- D. The territory proposed to be annexed shares a contiguous boundary with the municipality for a continuous length of at least 5% of the perimeter of the territory proposed to be annexed.

The Auglaize County PRC Program is intended to address the needs of the individual and the family, for the purpose of an adult family member obtaining employment while providing a stable home environment. Services are provided to prevent a household from reliance on Ohio Works First (OWF) cash assistance. PRC services are also provided to help people retain employment. Contingency services are provided to meet presenting needs that, if not satisfied, threatens the safety, health, or well-being of one or more minor members of the household. These services are limited to the amount and type of services required, not to exceed the parameters established herein. ACDJFS will inform all applicants of Food Stamps, Medicaid, Child Care, and Early Start availability; and,

WHEREAS, Director Morrow requested that the Board approve and execute the PRC Program, as presented, effective October 1, 2011.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners, Auglaize County, Ohio, does hereby approve the PRC Program plan as presented by Auglaize County Department of Job & Family Services Director; and,
