**WHEREAS**, such Employee currently performs work for the engineering department and the general revenue fund (as part of the tax map office) for an average of 48 hours per pay period; and,

**WHEREAS**, the EMA Office is in need of part time support.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Commissioners, Auglaize County, Ohio, does hereby approve the Memorandum of Understanding with the Auglaize County Commissioners, the Auglaize County Emergency Management Board and the Auglaize County Engineer for the part-time employee to provide support to the EMA Office; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board does hereby authorize the President of the Board, David Bambauer, to execute said Memorandum of Understanding and the MOU will be part of this resolution.

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

By and Between the

**Auglaize County Commissioners, the Auglaize County Emergency Management Board and the Auglaize County Engineer**

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into effective September 1, 2022 by and between the Auglaize County Commissioners ("**BOCC**"), the Auglaize County Emergency Management Board ("**EMA**"), and the Auglaize County Engineer (the "**Engineer**").

**WHEREAS**, the Engineer currently employees a part time individual (the "**Employee**"); and

**WHEREAS**, such Employee currently performs work for the both the engineering department and the general revenue fund (as part of the tax map office) for an average of 48 hours per pay period; and

**WHEREAS**, the EMA office is in need of part time support; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties believe it is in the best interest of the County to have the Employee provide such support to the EMA office; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties further believe it is in the best interest of all parties to establish parameters around the shared use of such Employee.

Therefore, it is understood and agreed by the parties as follows:

1. Each department shall be responsible for the hours that Employee works within such department.
2. If EMA has Employee work hours in excess of the 48 hours per pay which cause the Employee to become eligible for County benefits, including but not limited County insurance (at either the part time or full time rates), then such benefits shall be paid by EMA.
3. EMA shall be responsible for any overtime/comp time incurred by Employee unless all of Employee's hours worked which result in overtime/comp time benefits are exclusively because of hours worked for the Engineer.
4. If Employee leaves employment with the County and has earned paid time off that is due and payable, such paid time off shall be the responsibility of the department where such paid time off was earned.


