- 8:00 a.m. Commissioner Bergman moved to approve the resolutions. Commissioner Regula seconded the motion. The resolutions were then distributed for each Commissioner's vote and execution.
- 8:05 a.m. The Commissioners received and signed the check register as presented by the County Auditor's Office.
- 8:40 a.m. Clerk Leffel read the minutes of the August 30<sup>th</sup> and September 4th, 2018 meetings. The minutes were approved as read.
- 8:45 a.m. Clerk Leffel reported the following:
  - The caretaker's house at the fairgrounds has been demolished.
  - Received information from Palmer Energy on First Energy Solutions Financial update and forwarded the update to the following three Townships: Clay, Moulton and St. Marys.
  - The Teledoc drawing had 21 employees participate and selected the four \$25 drawing winners.
  - She asked if there are any questions on the financial reports she provided. There were no questions.
  - PY'16 CHIP monitoring is schedule for September 26th and 27<sup>th</sup> with ODSA and Poggemeyer Design Group.
  - Reviewed the calendar for the next several weeks.
  - Informed the Board that the PY'17 CDBG Allocation from the Village of Cridersville's park project can be reallocated with an amendment request from the Board. The Clerk will contact the City of St. Marys and confirm they are in favor of the amendment.
- 9:00 a.m. Extension personnel Beth Miller and Jeff Stachler provided the quarterly update of activities.
- 10:00 a.m. Administrator Preston conveyed the following:
  - Carpet cleaning is scheduled to be done in the months of October and November.
  - The Administration Building parking lot will be paved and striped this weekend.
  - The Board of Election Director has requested signage for handicapped parking to be added to the parking lot at the Fairgrounds and Administration Building.
  - The licensure application was filed for the continuance of operations has been initiated with the Department of Health.
  - The City of St. Marys has inquired if the County would support a green space application.
  - A former CHIP applicant has transferred the improved property to another person without the county's approval.
  - State Urban Forester Stephanie Miller has sent the information on the type of trees to be used on the south side of the parking lot at the Courthouse.
  - Rachel Barber inquired if the Board is keeping any of the historical furniture used at the Acres. The Board has this provision addressed in the agreement.

- Rachel also asked if the Board would consider planting flowers that will match others to be planted in Wapakoneta for the celebration of the anniversary of Neil Armstrong's first walk on the moon.
- The St. Marys Township Trustees will be sending payment for the law enforcement vehicle to be used in the respective township.
- She has spoken to an interested party to serve on the public defender commission. She asked the individual to submit a letter of interest.
- She is doing research on the process of design/build procedure.
- Commissioner Bergman asked about the status of the harvest of timber in the Acres woods. He reviewed the hay ground area in Uniopolis and the leasee intends to have a 4<sup>th</sup> cutting of hay and stated that the parking is being moved to the Knoch's parking lot for this weekend.
