RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Auglaize County Juvenile Court Judge Mark Spees has presented a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Auglaize County Ohio Juvenile Court by and through the Auglaize County Board of Commissioners and the Wapakoneta City Schools for the student instructional and social services for juvenile probation youth; and,

WHEREAS, the Auglaize County Ohio Juvenile Court agrees to pay Wapakoneta City Schools a lump sum payment of \$40,000. Judge Spees approves and recommends that the Board of Auglaize County Commissioners approve and execute said Memorandum of Understanding.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners, Auglaize County, Ohio, does hereby approve the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Auglaize County Ohio Juvenile Court by and through the Auglaize County Board of Commissioners and the Wapakoneta City Schools for the above stated program.

IN THE MATTER OF AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT (ODOD) FOR THE BROWNFIELD REMEDIATION PROGRAM – FY 2027.

The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio met in regular session on the 8th day of September, 2026.

Commissioner Bambauer moved the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners received notification from the Ohio Department of Development (ODOD) of the possible funding through the Brownfield Remediation Program for FY 2027 for a state-wide competitive pool of approximately \$120 million to fund eligible projects. A brownfield is an abandoned, idled, or under-used industrial, commercial, or institutional property where expansion or redevelopment is complicated by known or potential releases of hazardous substances or petroleum; and,

WHEREAS, the Board solicited projects with all townships, villages and cities for funding consideration to be submitted immediately to meet the September 11, 2026 application deadline; and,

WHEREAS, the Board received two projects; and,

WHEREAS, the Phase I (VAP), Phase II, and RAP have been completed for both projects; and,

WHEREAS, the County Administrator requested the authority to execute the Right of Entry agreements that may be needed for the said two projects; and,

WHEREAS, the grant application will consists of two projects:

Former Muffler Mart - 110 Pearl Street, Wapakoneta – “Muffler Mart”

Precision Strip, Inc. oldest Post Printing building- Minster – “PSI”

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio does hereby authorize the County Administrator to proceed with the submittal of an application for FY 2027 to the Ohio Department of Development Services for the Brownfield Remediation Program – FY 2027 funding; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board does ratify the signature of the County Administrator on the Right of Entry Agreements needed for said projects as applicable.
